### David Hockney - 1937



- Hockney is an English artist and an important contributor to the Pop Art movement
- He is considered to be one of the most influential British artists of the 20<sup>th</sup> century
- In 1964, Hockney moved to Los Angeles, where he became fascinated by water, making a series of paintings of swimming pools.
- He used printmaking for much of his work, in the form of etchings and lithographs

### Pop Art

- Pop Art was a style of art in the 1960s that was bright, full of colour as they felt that up until this time, art did not represent the younger generation.
- Influential pop artists, include Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein
